Dear Parent or Guardian:

Parents and guardians are a child's first and most influential teachers. As such, can choose to opt their students out of Comprehensive Sexuality Education. Families considering this option may do so with or without previewing the materials.

According to Oregon Law (<u>OAR Rule 581-022-1440</u>), parents can opt their children out of any or all sexuality education components. However, parents cannot opt their children out of the entire health curriculum without written documentation of a religious or disability-related reason.

The opt-out process is as follows:

 After previewing materials, if a parent/guardian would like to excuse their child from instruction, complete and submit this Opt-Out Notice to the school principal.

Plan for alternative instruction:

• If a student is opted-out of a portion of the instruction, the teacher is responsible for ensuring that appropriate alternative materials are available for the student. The alternative materials will be noted in the grade level scope & sequence available online or in the school office.
